## Wisconsin Waterfowl Association: Decoy Carving Competition & Exhibition – Exhibitor Agreement

Thank you for your interest in our First Annual Decoy Carving Competition weekend. We are very excited for this inaugural competition and hope it continues for many years to come. Our objectives for the Competition are as follows:

1. To honor the traditions of hand-carved working decoys that have played an important role in water fowling in Wisconsin and throughout much of the United States
2. To showcase the decoys of the best carvers in Wisconsin and the United States, providing opportunities to compete, learn, and network for carvers of all levels, from first time competitors to world champions.
3. To encourage and influence waterfowlers and artists to continue the practice and art of making hand carved decoys for actual gunning, for competition, and as unique pieces of art.
4. To include vendors, displays, and demonstrations at this competition that will initiate participation by Wisconsin hunters, artists, and youth in decoy carving and decoy competitions.
5. Identify Wisconsin decoy artists by region, location, and interest, forming a database of talent that can be contacted to assist as judges, instructors/demonstrators, volunteers, committee members, and mentors.

If you are interested in exhibiting at our First Annual Decoy Carving Competition or becoming involved in future competitions please review this agreement, and fill out our exhibitor application form. This DCCE Exhibitor Agreement is made this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 2017, between Wisconsin Waterfowl Association (WWA) and \_\_\_\_\_ with its principal location at: \_\_\_\_\_ (Exhibitor).

1. Purpose: Exhibitor shall provide an exhibit, or items offered for sale, of hard lines or tourism at the 2017 Decoy Carving Competition & Exhibition, located in the Laird Room, of Dreyfus Hall, at UW-Stevens Point, scheduled for operation from **9:30-4:30 pm on Friday, September 15<sup>th</sup>**, and **9:30-4:00 pm on Saturday, September 16<sup>th</sup>**, 2017. This event will run concurrently with the Federal Duck Stamp art judging, also held on campus at this time.
2. Location, date & time: The location shall be selected by WWA, out of the space available in the Laird Room, found on the second floor of Dreyfus Hall, at the University. The DCCE will run, at the times stated above, on the 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>. No access to the Laird Room will be available before or after those times, with the exception of an opportunity for “set-up” on **Friday the 15<sup>th</sup>, from 7am-9:30am**, on **Saturday the 16<sup>th</sup>, from 7am to 9:30am**, for “display maintenance”, and on **Saturday the 16<sup>th</sup>, from 4:30pm-6:30pm** for “tear-down & removal” of displays. As the exhibit spaces are small, and the expected displays are expected to be relatively simple, these arrangements are expected to be sufficient. Exhibitors should expect to be available for the entirety of the “open” time on Friday and Saturday.
3. Termination/extension of Agreement: This Agreement shall remain in effect through the completion of the undertakings contemplated herein, subject to WWA’s right to terminate for breach by Exhibitor. The indemnification and general provisions of this Agreement shall survive termination or expiration.
4. Designated location: WWA will provide the location for the exhibitor’s space, out of the area provide in the Laird Room, as noted above. There are only five (5) “bulk” display areas available, and thirteen (13) table spaces available, and all have excellent visibility/traffic flow for visitors to the Laird Room for the event.
5. Certain exhibitor responsibilities:

Conduct in keeping with a family friend festival: during the exhibition, the Exhibitor shall not conduct its activities or provide any products or services that Exhibitor knows or should know to be, or which WWA in its sole discretion deems immoral, illegal, inappropriate, unsafe, unlicensed, or otherwise objectionable. WWA official listed below shall have the authority to immediately close any exhibit or activity that WWA deems objectionable. This official is: Don Kirby.

Attire: Exhibitor shall require all of its employees & representatives to be professionally and modestly dressed in a standard uniform or “business casual” attire, and shall present themselves and conduct themselves in

connection with the exhibition in a manner that is consistent with the family friendly nature of the DCCE. Exhibitor representatives shall wear shirts at all times, including set-up, take-down, and during the exhibition.

Alcohol, tobacco & drug use: Exhibitor shall ensure that none of its representatives use or are under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs at the DCCE. There is no smoking while working at the exhibition.

Music: Exhibitor shall not allow any of its representatives to play music or other sounds or announcements that emit from its exhibit space, that WWA deems objectionable either in content or volume. On the first offense, Exhibitor shall be required to ensure the music or noise is turned off or down, as designated by WWA. On any subsequent offense, Exhibitor shall close the attraction from which the music or noise is emanating from, for the duration of the exhibit, or until such time as WWA designates.

Electrical power: Exhibitor shall furnish all electrical power required for the operation of their exhibit. No generators allowed, as the DCCE is indoors. *(limited supply of 110v AC may be available, but cannot be assured)*

Trash: Exhibitor shall be responsible for garbage collection within the premises of their exhibit. Exhibitor shall restore the area occupied by their display to its prior condition upon conclusion of the DCCE. Such restoration shall include cleaning and removal from the site of all refuse and debris.

Safety standards: Exhibitor shall comply with all safety standards under applicable law and regulation to operate the exhibition. Exhibitor shall provide WWA with copies of any/all safety inspection forms, as may be appropriate to their display, and other documentation demonstrating compliance.

Federal, state, and local laws: Exhibitor shall operate their display/exhibition in accordance with all applicable Federal, state, and local laws, rules and ordinances, including but not limited to: any and all state/county/local sales tax collection on sales made, all worker's compensation and employer's liability insurance requirements. In the event the exhibitor subcontracts any work for their display/exhibition, the exhibitor shall require the subcontractor(s) to similarly provide worker's compensation insurance as required by the laws of the State of Wisconsin. Violation by exhibitor of any law, ordinance or regulation shall be grounds for WWA closing their display/exhibit for the remainder of the DCCE, and WWA shall incur no liability to exhibitor, should it do so.

#### General provisions:

Governing law: This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Wisconsin and the parties stipulate that any lawsuit regarding this Agreement or the performance hereunder may be brought in Green Bay, Wisconsin.

Modification; severability: This Agreement shall not be amended or modified except by written document signed by the party to be charged with such amendment or modification. If any provision hereof is declared or adjudicated by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, it shall be deemed deleted from this Agreement without impairing the legality, validity or enforceability of the remaining provisions hereof.

Notices: Any notice, demand, request, consent, approval or other communication (collectively, the "Notices") required or permitted to be given by any provision of this Agreement shall be in writing and hand delivered, sent by special courier, or by U.S. Certified Mail (return receipt requested, postage prepaid) addressed to the party to be so notified. Notice pursuant to this Agreement shall be deemed given pursuant to the following rules: if hand delivered or sent by special courier, at the time of delivery, if mailed, on the later of the date of receipt or the third day of U.S. Mail delivery after deposit thereof in the U.S. Mail.

Force Majeure and Cancellation: WWA shall not be liable for any damages as a result of any delay or cancellation of the DCCE due to any cause beyond its reasonable control, including without limitation: any storms, weather emergencies, accidents, strikes, breakdowns, labor disputes, riots, sabotage, insurrection or
